4 Use Speakerphone

- Connect your speakerphone to remote conference.
- 1) Connect to PC or other conference host via USB cable.
- 2) Connect to the host via 3.5mm audio cable. For example, connect mobile phone and start remote conference through the mobile app.
- 3) Connect speakerphone via Bluetooth (Without as default).
- The M200 speakerphone can be charged via USB cable.
- Use the volume up/down button to adjust the volume.

- To connect to the M200 via Bluetooth (without as default), select the Bluetooth device B100 (default name) on the host to connect.
- If you are connected to a Windows host, use the system control panel
 to adjust the recording and playback volume to the appropriate location.
 For Windows 7 and Windows 8, click Start > Control Panel > Hardware
 and Sound > Sounds > Play and Record tab; for Windows 10, right-click
 the Windows logo, click Control Panel > Hardware and Sound >
 Sounds > Play and Record tab.
